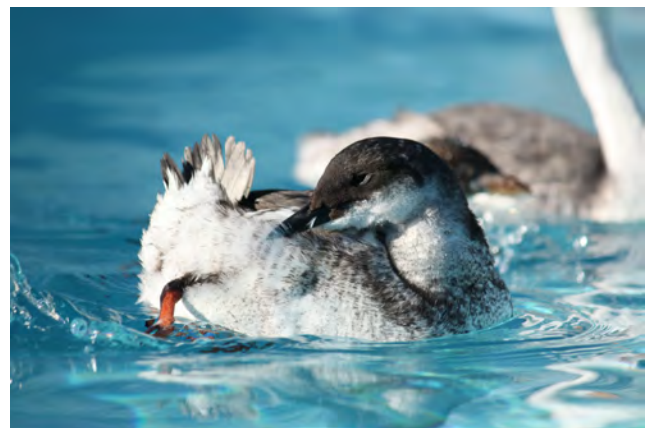
International Bird Rescue has been saving seabirds and other avian species since 1971.
